

The participating groups **in the 25 in 5 Network** succeeded in convincing MPP's to amend the government's legislation so that Bill 152 now has stronger language about reducing poverty for groups besides the government's emphasis on children, stronger wording about the government's intention to take a leading role in reducing poverty, and a specific date, March 31<sup>st</sup>, to report the legislature in an annual report.

The **Worker's Action Centre and Parkdale Community Legal Service**, as well as labour unions, succeeded in winning amendments to the provincial government's Bill 139 to protect the rights of temporary workers. For more information about the Bill visit <http://www.workersactioncentre.org/>
